❖ **Theme**

- Urban youth's perspectives on making a future in Cameroon or abroad
- Primary focus on migration and translocality
- Secondary focus on the role of education and job opportunities in Cameroon

❖ **Organizers**

❖ **Schedule**

Participants from the University of Cologne are obliged to stay at least 6 weeks in Cameroon and participate in the following activities:

- Week 1, Monday to Friday, 30.7.-3.8.18: intensive preparatory seminar in Yaoundé
- Week 2-5: fieldwork in the respective field sites (Cameroonian-German research tandems)
- Week 6, Monday to Friday, 3.-7.9.18: evaluation seminar in Yaoundé, writing report

❖ **Travel grants will cover the following expenses**

- International flight, local transport in Cameroon
- Accommodation in Yaoundé and in the respective fieldsite
- Joint research activities and excursions

NB: Visa costs and international health insurance have to be covered and organized by participants themselves

❖ **Eligibility**

- Students registered at the University of Cologne in Cultural and Social Anthropology or related disciplines, preferably at MA level
- Obligatory participation in the preparatory seminar taught by Prof. Pelican in SoSe 2018
